

A Guide to Historical Bellevue Sites

“The Birthplace of Nebraska”

Log Cabin, 1805 Hancock Street. Build of hand-hewn cottonwood in the 1830's. The cabin is the oldest structure in Nebraska.

Fontenelle Bank, 2212 Main Street. Revival architecture. Built in 1856 of handmade bricks. First bank incorporated in Nebraska Territory.

Omaha and Southern Railroad Depot, next to the Sarpy County Historical Museum. Built in 1836, it is the oldest train depot in Nebraska.

First Presbyterian Church, 2002 Franklin Street. Constructed between 1856 and 1858. Oldest remaining pioneer religious structure in Nebraska.

Sarpy County Historical Museum, 2402 Clay Street. Displays and artifacts from Nebraska's historical past. Open year-round.
